## Aluminium legs Trestle table

Arco has decided to use the traditional “Coquille casting technique” for the production of the legs of the Trestle table. With this production technique the aluminium is scooped with a mug from a melting furnace and then cast into the mould (the Coquille).

The quick solidification in the mould creates a fine-grained structure. This structure is comparable with that of an orange. Characteristic of this technique is that small holes are visible on the surface. Another feature is that there may be shallow stripes on the surface. The surface may also include small protruding lumps. These features are inherent to this casting process.

The legs can best be cleaned with a slightly moist cleaning cloth and you may also use (a soapy) water.
